

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

of March 12, 2020 No. 194

the Government, pursuant to Articles 5 and 6 of the constitutional act No. 110/1998 Coll., on security of the Czech Republic

declares

for the territory of the Czech Republic due to the risks for public health in connection with the evidenced occurrence of the coronavirus /referred to as SARS CoV-2/ in the territory of the Czech Republic

THE STATE OF EMERGENCY

for the period of 30 days, starting from March 12, 2020, 14:00 hours.

The Government

I. Orders, pursuant to Section 5(a-e) and Section 6 of the act No. 240/2000 Coll., on emergency management and amending of several acts (the emergency act), as amended, emergency measures to solve the emergency situation. Their specific implementation shall be specified by a separate resolution of the Government

II. Authorizes

1. the prime minister to manage and coordinate tasks as per the point I;
2. the members of the government to request the Government to grant prior consent to measures related to the state of emergency within the scope of their powers before such measures are implemented;

III. the currently issued and valid extraordinary measures of the Ministry of Healthcare remain unaffected by this declaration of the state of emergency;

IV. this resolution becomes effective on March 12, 2020 at 14:00 and it expires upon elapse of 30 days after the date of effect;

IV. instructs the prime minister to inform the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Republic immediately about the declaration of the state of emergency as per point I of this resolution.
