REGULATION OF THE GOVERNMENT

of March 17, 2020

on ban on distribution of drugs in connection with the epidemy of the SARS-CoV-2 virus

The Government orders, pursuant to Section 22(1)(d) of the act No. 241/2000 Coll., on economic measures in emergency situations and amending of several related acts, as amended:

Section 1

In connection with the state of emergency, declared by the Government on March 12, 2020 due to the threat to health in connection with the evidenced occurrence of the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus it is prohibited to supply any registered medicinal products designated for the market of the Czech Republic to other member states of the European Union and export of these medicinal products to other states than the member states of the European Union.

Section 2

- (1) This regulation becomes effective on the day of its publication.
- (2) This regulation expires upon expiry of the state of emergency specified in Section 1 hereof.
