

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 18, 2020, No. 248

on the adoption of an emergency measure

Following the resolution of the Government No. 194 dated March 12, 2020, according to which the Government declared, pursuant to Articles 5 and 6 of the constitutional act No. 110/1998 Coll., on security of the Czech Republic, the state of emergency for the territory of the Czech Republic due to the risks for public health in connection with the evidenced occurrence of the coronavirus /referred to as SARS CoV-2/ in the territory of the Czech Republic, and ruled to adopt emergency measures pursuant to Section 5(a-e) and Section 6 of the act No. 240/2000 Coll., on emergency management and amending of several acts (the emergency act), as amended, to solve the emergency situation, hereby, pursuant to Section 5(e) and Section 6(1)(b) of the emergency act.

The Government

- I. Forbids, with effect as of March 19, 2020, 00:00 hours, everyone to move and stay in any places except for place of residence without means of protection of respiratory tract (nose, mouth), such as respirator, mask, scarf or other means of avoiding the spread of droplet infection;
- II. Orders all persons who have an exception for cross-border workers to restrict their movement in the Czech Republic to the necessary minimum. The exceptions as per resolution of the Government of March 15, 2020 No. 215 as per points
 - a) I/b (necessary trips to visit family members or close persons);
 - b) I/d (trips, which are necessary to ensure needs and services as per letter c) for another person (e.g. volunteering, neighbor help);
 - I/f, second part of the sentence (trips to handle necessary official matters which cannot be postponed, including necessary accompanying of related and close persons);
 - d) I/h (stay in nature or in parks);

do not apply to such persons.

- **III. Highlights** that the persons specified in point II hereof are subject to all measures arising out of all other resolutions (in particular, the obligation to wear means of protection of respiratory tract);
- IV. Orders all persons specified in point II hereof (cross-border workers) to allow, when crossing the state border, an examination of symptoms of infection diseases and, if any symptoms are if infection disease are detected, to provide necessary collaboration to healthcare workers to take biological samples to establish the presence of the COVID-19 disease.
