

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 19, 2020, No. 255

on a bill on certain adjustments to social security in the context of the emergency measures during an epidemic in 2020

The Government

- I. approves bill on certain adjustments to social security in the context of the emergency measures during an epidemic in 2020, as amended according to the comments contained in the opinion of the President of the Governmental Legislative Council and amendments according to the comments of the Government;
- **II. instructs** the Minister of Labor and Social Affairs to draw up the final wording of the government bill pursuant to point I of this resolution;

III. requests

- 1. the President of the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Parliament, to decide that the government's bill referred to in point I and II of this resolution will be discussed in the abridge hearing within the declared state of legislative emergency,
- 2. the President of the Senate of the Czech Parliament to ensure the Senate of the Czech Parliament to discuss the government's bill referred to in point I and II of this resolution in the abridge hearing;

IV. authorizes

- 1. the prime minister to submit
- a) the government bill pursuant to point I and II of this resolution to the President of the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Parliament for further discussion,
- b) the proposal pursuant to point III/1 of this resolution to the President of the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Parliament,
- c) the request pursuant to point III/2 of this resolution to the President of the Senate of the Czech Republic,
- 2. the Minister of Labour and Social Affairs to justify the government's bill in the Parliament of the Czech Republic;
- V. empowers the prime minister to authorize, following a reasoned request from the Minister of Labour and Social Affairs, a member of the Government to carry out the task referred to in point IV/2 of this resolution.
