

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 19, 2020, No. 264

on adopting an emergency measure

Following the Governmental Resolution No. 194 dated March 12, 2020, by which the Government, in line with Art. 5 and 6 of the Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency for the territory of the Czech Republic due to threat of health in connection to proven outbreak of coronavirus designated SARS CoV-2 in the territory of the Czech Republic and in line with Section 5 letter a) to e) and Section 6 of the Act No. 24/2000 Coll., on Emergency Operation and on change of other Acts ("Emergency Act"), as amended, for the purpose of resolving the emergency situation, the Government hereby decided on adoption of emergency measures, under Section 5 letter e) and Section 6 (1) letter b) of the Emergency Act, as follows:

The Government

instructs that the prohibition of the retail sales and sales of services in establishment, stipulated in the point I/1 of the Resolution of the Government dated March 14, 2020 No. 211, issued under No. 82/2020 Coll., is furthermore not applicable towards real estate agents, and the activity of financial advisors, maintenance of accounts, maintenance of tax evidence.
