



RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 23, 2020, No. 275

on adopting an emergency measure

Following the Governmental Resolution No. 194 dated March 12, 2020, by which the Government, in line with Art. 5 and 6 of the Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency for the territory of the Czech Republic due to threat of health in connection to proven outbreak of coronavirus designated SARS CoV-2 in the territory of the Czech Republic and in line with Section 5 letter a) to e) and Section 6 of the Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on Emergency Operation and on change of other Acts ("Emergency Act"), as amended, for the purpose of resolving the emergency situation, the Government hereby decided on adoption of emergency measures, under Section 6 (1) letter c) of the Emergency Act, as follows:

The Government, with effect from March 24, 2020, from 00:00 a.m. for the duration of the state of emergency

States that the operator of the information system of data boxes is not entitled to a remuneration pursuant to Section 18a (3) of the Act No. 300/2008 Coll., on electronic operations and authorised conversion of documents, as amended.
