



RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 23, 2020, No. 276

on adopting an emergency measure

Following the Governmental Resolution No. 194 dated March 12, 2020, by which the Government, in line with Art. 5 and 6 of the Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency for the territory of the Czech Republic due to threat of health in connection to proven outbreak of coronavirus designated SARS CoV-2 in the territory of the Czech Republic and in line with Section 5 letter a) to e) and Section 6 of the Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on Emergency Operation and on change of other Acts ("Emergency Act"), as amended, for the purpose of resolving the emergency situation, the Government hereby decided on adoption of emergency measures, under Section 6 (1) letter c) and Section 6 (2) letter e) of the Emergency Act, as follows:

The Government

orders that the necessary care for children aged between 3 and 10 years provided for in point I of the Governmental resolution of March 15, 2020, No. 219, published under No. 89/2020 Coll., applies also to children whose legal representatives are employees of the municipalities included in the municipal authorities to carry out social work, employees of the regions included in the regional authorities to carry out social work and employees of the social service providers.
