

RESOLUTION

OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 23, 2020, No. 278

on adopting an emergency measure

Following the Governmental Resolution No. 194 dated March 12, 2020, by which the Government, in line with Art. 5 and 6 of the Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency for the territory of the Czech Republic due to threat of health in connection to proven outbreak of coronavirus /designated SARS CoV-2/ in the territory of the Czech Republic and in line with Section 5 letter a) to e) and Section 6 of the Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on Emergency Operation and on change of other Acts ("Emergency Act"), as amended, for the purpose of resolving the emergency situation, the Government hereby decided on adoption of emergency measures, under Section 5 letter c) and Section 6 (1) letter c) of the Emergency Act, as follows:

The Government with the effect as of March 24, 2020

- I. prohibits all employees, which perform a medical occupation under the Act No. 95/2004 Coll., on Conditions of Acquiring and Recognizing Professional Qualification and Specialized Qualification to Perform Medical Occupation of Doctor, Dentist and Pharmacist, as amended, and under the Act No. 96/2004 Coll., on Conditions of Acquiring and Recognizing Professional Qualification to Perform Paramedical (Nonmedical) Occupation and to Perform Activities Related to Provision of Health Care and on change of other Acts, as amended (the Act on Non-Doctorial Medical Occupations), as amended, drawing of the holiday for the period of the state of emergency, with the exception of persons, who were ordered a quarantine
- **II.** cancels the Governmental Resolution dated March 15, 2020, No. 216.
