



RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 26, 2020, No. 302

on allocating budget means from the chapter General Treasury Management, item Governmental Budget Reserve, to secure food self-sufficiency and to reduce the impact of the crisis situation caused by the coronavirus pandemic using instruments implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture – current measures of Podpůrný a garanční rolnický a lesnický fond, a.s.

The Government:

I. approves

1. the allocation of budget means from the chapter General Treasury Management, item Governmental Budget Reserve, to secure food self-sufficiency and to reduce the impact of the crisis situation caused by the coronavirus pandemic using instruments implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture – current measures of Podpůrný a garanční rolnický a lesnický fond, a.s., included in part III of the material Ref. No. 265/20 in order to secure food self-sufficiency,
2. the mobilisation of funds in 2020 from the budget chapter General Treasury Management, item Governmental Budget Reserve in the amount of CZK 1 billion to the budget of the chapter no. 329 – Ministry of Agriculture in order to secure the self-sufficiency measure of Podpůrný a garanční rolnický a lesnický fond, a.s. to secure food self-sufficiency and to reduce the impact of the crisis caused by the coronavirus pandemic as defined in the Governmental Resolution dated March, 23, 2020, No. 288,

II. instructs

1. the Minister of Agriculture
 - a) to submit a request pursuant to paragraph I/2 of this Resolution to the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance
 - b) utilize said budget appropriations to strengthen the budget of Podpůrný a garanční rolnický a lesnický fond, a.s., in 2020,
2. the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance to carry out a fiscal measure on the basis of a request referred to under paragraph II/1a).
