

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

dated March 26, 2020, No. 310

## on adopting an emergency measure

Following the Governmental Resolution No. 194 dated March 12, 2020, by which the Government, in line with Art. 5 and 6 of the Constitutional Act No. 110/1998 Coll., on Security of the Czech Republic, declared a state of emergency for the territory of the Czech Republic due to threat of health in connection to proven outbreak of coronavirus designated SARS CoV-2 in the territory of the Czech Republic and in line with Section 5 letter a) to e) and Section 6 of the Act No. 240/2000 Coll., on Emergency Operation and on change of other Acts ("Emergency Act"), as amended, for the purpose of resolving the emergency situation, the Government hereby decided on adoption of emergency measures, under Section 5 letter c) and Section 6 (1) letter b) of the Emergency Act, as follows:

## The Government

**I. acknowledges** the exemption granted by the Minister of Interior from the Governmental Resolution dated March 12, 2020 No. 198 and dated March 13, 2020 No. 203 for cross-border workers who work in the health sector, social services and services of the integrated rescue system;

## **II.** provides, that

- 1. the persons referred to in point I of this resolution continue to be subject to the obligations under the Governmental Resolution dated March 18, 2020 No. 247 (stricter movement restrictions on the territory of the Czech Republic, a ban on stay outside place of residence without respiratory protective means);
- 2. the persons referred to in point I of this resolution are no longer subject to the obligations under the Governmental Resolution dated March 19, 2020 No. 267 (cross-border worker's book) and Governmental Resolution dated March 23, 2020 No. 281 (system 3+2, mandatory post-arrival guarantine).
