## **DECISION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CAPITAL CITY OF PRAGUE**

on the ban of entry, stay and movement of persons in the territory of the capital city of Prague at the state of emergency of March 17, 2020 No. 2/2020/COV19

Pursuant to Section 14(4)(h) of the act No. 240/2000 Coll., on emergency management and amending of several acts, as amended (the "emergency act") and in relation to the state of emergency declared by the Government of the Czech Republic of March 12, 2020 No. 194

### **I order ban on entry, stay and movement of the public without protective equipment of respiratory tracts (masks, respirators, scarfs and similar fabric)**

to vehicles of public mass transportation, establishments operation of which is permitted during the state of emergency, social and healthcare facilities, premises of public authorities, administrative bodies and the integrated emergency system, educational facilities, post offices, pharmacies and platforms for vehicles of public mass transportation (if the premises are not clear or if such a space is not otherwise specified, a platform is deemed to be a freely accessible area, which is 5 meters wide and 30 meters long before and 5 meters beyond the marking sign of the station in the driving direction of the vehicle) in the territory of the capital city of Prague

**starting from March 18, 2020, 12:00 until further notice, but, in any event, during the duration of the state of emergency**

The persons shall respect instructions of the emergency management authorities and members of security and armed forces, who guard and monitor the situation.

### **Reasoning**

The ban on entry, stay and movement of persons in the specified person or territory is ordered due to an urgent public interest of avoiding the threat to lives, health and property of residents of the territory in which the state of emergency is declared.

### **Advice**

This decision cannot be appealed.

Compensation of material damage sustained as a result of authorities executing the emergency operation Section 35 and 36 of the emergency act shall apply. Monetary compensation shall be paid by the emergency management authority which ordered the restriction of a right or imposed an obligation. The monetary compensation is payable within 6 months from the termination or cancellation of the state of emergency, during which the claim for monetary compensation arose.

If obligations stipulated by this decisions are not fulfilled, a fine up to CZK 20 000 can be imposed according to Section 34 of the emergency act.

This decision becomes effective on March 17, 2020.
